



# SNUGBOROUGH INTERCHANGE UPGRADE



## Project Update / Information Details



BAM Civil Ltd. have been working with Fingal County Council on the Snugborough Interchange Upgrade Scheme.

We are currently in month 16 of our 24 month contract programme. In the past 16 months we have completed numerous elements such as installation of the new bridge over the N3 and pedestrian bridge, underpasses and retaining walls at various locations especially along the N3. Work continues on the Road & Pedestrian route realignment at the Waterville Road Roundabout Junction which has seen a relocation of the roundabout to allow excavation works to proceed. A further relocation will be required to complete the new underpass and construct the permanent footpaths and cycle tracks. Further realignment works are occurring along the L3020 which will allow access to the new bridge.

Further traffic management measures will be deployed on Snugborough Road and the surrounding road networks over the coming months as work continues. There will be continued closures of inbound and outbound hard shoulder and bus lanes on the N3 as we begin the finishing works to the underside of the new bridge. Every effort will be made to minimise the disruption throughout the works.

# TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Further traffic management measures will be required as works progress on the scheme into Q2/3 of 2022. These additional traffic management measures are required to facilitate key elements of construction including concrete underpasses, drainage and utility ducting install, retaining walls & service diversions. Note that lane restrictions of the N3 in each direction will continue up to Q3.

## Principal Traffic Management Installations July 2022 – September 2022

- N3 Inbound Bus Lane Closure
- N3 Outbound Hard Shoulder Closure
- Waterville Road & Roundabout Realignment – Phase 2.
- Footpath Closure on the L3020 adjacent N3 will re-open with the opposite side closing for drainage/duct works to proceed.
- Path closure adjacent to the works within Tolka Valley Park will remain including Old Corduff Road underpass area.

As changes are made, we will update our website with the latest information and every effort will be made to minimise disruption to local road users.

Please remember to drive with caution and be mindful of the changes in road layout and be aware of increased numbers of construction vehicles on the roads as the project progresses.

## July – September 2022

BAM will continue through this period to install drainage, utility services and footpaths around Waterville Rd Junction, the L3020, new bridge and realigned Snugborough Road North. This will allow for the construction of new footpath and cycle lanes around the junction. As part of the realignment of the Old Corduff Pedestrian Route, the second phase of an underpass will be installed in Waterville Roundabout. This will form part of the permanent realignment of the Snugborough Road once complete. New footpaths & cycletracks will start being opened to the public in this period. Retaining walls either side of the junction and along boundary of Tolka Valley Park will be completed in this period.

BAM and Fingal County Council, would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your patience during the construction of this exciting project.

Due to the complex nature of the scheme, it is often necessary to make road layout changes. Look out for site information boards and signage on the route, which is provided for your safety.
