

SNUGBOROUGH INTERCHANGE UPGRADE



Project Update / Information Details



BAM Civil Ltd. have been working with Fingal County Council on the Snugborough Interchange Upgrade Scheme.

The Snugborough Interchange is currently programmed to be substantially completed at road level in late March 2024. The work on completing the underpasses and Tolka Park paths will be the last element of the works and will be completed during April 2024.

Road surfacing works are continuing to various areas on both sides of the interchange and traffic will be diverted to the new bridge in mid-December 2023. Further traffic management measures will be deployed for this diversion. The Waterville Junction and Snugborough Road area will also see lane capacity increased (southbound) in mid-December to aid traffic congestion around the temporary roundabout area.

Every effort will be made to minimise the disruption throughout the works. This is a complex scheme which has involved a lot of utility diversions in order to complete new structures. For further information on this project please visit our project website www.snugboroughinterchange.ie

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Further traffic management measures will be required as works progress on the scheme into December of 2023 and early 2024. These additional traffic management measures are required to switch traffic to the new bridge, resurface existing bridge and to complete paths, drainage and utility ducting install, along with new cycle tracks.

Principal Traffic Management Installations December 2023 – January 2024

- Waterville Road – T- Junction is now in operation as per permanent arrangement, albeit more lanes will be open on completion. i.e. right-hand lane turning north onto Snugborough road.
- Access to Tolka Valley Park west upper-level path will be re-opened locally from the new footpath off the new bridge in mid-December.
- Pedestrian crossing points around the 5-arm junction have commenced to be relocated. This will allow the remaining new islands to be built and for traffic to be switched to the new bridge on w/c 11/12/23. Final surfacing to L3020 by E-Bay.
- From 1st December, N3 Off-Ramp temporary alignment has been realigned for the Christmas period to allow 3 lanes for traffic.
- Current path closure from the Old Corduff Road underpass area to Main Street at Clonsilla Road will remain closed until April 2024.
- Works will commence after Christmas around Circle K on Main Street.

December 2023 – March 2024

BAM will continue through this period to install drainage and utility services around Main Street (Circle K) with a particular emphasis on road surfacing around Waterville, the 5–arm junction, the L3020 and realigned Snugborough Road North & South. This will allow for traffic to be placed into permanent alignment and create additional lanes for traffic on the new bridge and Snugborough Road North. Also, construction of new footpath and cycle lanes will continue. The Waterville T-Junction is now open, the old roundabout is fully excavated, retaining walls and watermains are being installed in order to form the new pathway from Blanchardstown Village to Corduff which will open in April 2024. Every effort is being made to minimise disruption to local road users. Please be mindful of the changes in road layout as the project progresses.

Due to the complex nature of the scheme, it is often necessary to make road & footpath layout changes. Look out for site information boards and signage on the route, which is provided for your safety in addition to regular updates on the project website.
